

Toxic Microwave Popcorn


What We Found

- 100% of the popcorn bags tested had toxic chemicals called per/polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS)
- PFAS mimics the hormone estrogen and have been linked to liver and kidney toxicity [[m][m]]
- Our testing included major brands like ACT II, Pop Secret, Orville Redenbacher's, Popweaver, Regal Cinemas, and Clover Valley

Make Your Own Popcorn

Ingredients

Brown paper bag, popcorn kernels, oil, salt

Easy Directions

In a small bowl, mix together the popcorn kernels, oil, and salt. Pour the coated corn into the brown paper bag (double bag to prevent oil from leaking through) and fold over the bag twice to seal in the ingredients. Microwave the popcorn for about 2-3 min. Voila!
